The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., on the basis of compromise, is seeking quashing of FIR No.345 dated 02.03.2022 under Section 174A of IPC, registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram (Annexure P-4) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel on instruction from Investigating Officer submitted that State has no objection if FIR and consequent proceedings in view of order dated 14.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-17481-2022 are quashed.

By even dated order, FIR No.21 dated 09.01.2018 under Sections 363 and 366 of IPC (Sections 363A and 366A of IPC deleted later on), registered at Police Station Gurgaon Sadar, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1) which is foundation of impugned FIR stands quashed.

In view of above facts and circumstances, the present petition deserves to be allowed and accordingly allowed.

FIR No.345 dated 02.03.2022 under Section 174A of IPC, registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram (Annexure P-4) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner(s).
