Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for directions to the respondents for issuance of a direction to respondent No.12 to show cause as to how and why he intentionally failed to register an FIR as per Annexure P-1, when a clear-cut case was made out to register an FIR against all the concerned officers of Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 22.06.2018.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 5 has filed status report dated 10.10.2022, same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for UT on instructions from ASI Ram Chander submits that FIR No.200 dated 25.06.2018 has already been registered in this case. He submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may
