This appeal has been filed by the appellant – wife challenging judgment and decree dated 02.03.2020 passed by the learned Family Court, Gurdaspur whereby petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent – husband, has been allowed.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and he has instructions to withdraw this appeal. Learned counsel for the respondent affirms and verifies that the matter has indeed been settled amicably.
