HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Gurmeet Singh) has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing of order dated 13.11.2019 (Annexure P-9) passed by respondent No.3 - the Secretary Transport, Chandigarh Administration, whereby the statutory appeal No.10 of 2019 filed by the petitioner had been dismissed. A further prayer has been made for directing the respondents to release the service benefits of petitioner, i.e. gratuity, pension etc., to which he is entitled for.

2. A perusal of file reveals that when the matter was taken up for hearing on 08.08.2022, the following order was passed by this Court:-

*“There is again no representation on behalf of the
petitioner.*

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 11.01.2023.

In case, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the next date of hearing, this petition may be dismissed.”
