1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 11.04.2016 (Anenxure P-4) and order dated 08.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) with the plea that the petitioner had filed the revision petition before respondent the Commissioner, but due to prevailing situation of Covid-19, the said revision petition could not be taken up.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that in the present writ petition, the revision petition filed before the Commissioner has been dismissed, vide order dated 18.10.2021 and the matter has been remanded. It is further submitted that the said revision petition was filed against the same two orders dated 11.04.2016 and 08.05.2017 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), which have also been sought to be challenged in the present

writ petition.

3. A copy of the said order dated 18.10.2021 produced by learned State counsel today in the Court is taken on record and the same has been marked as “Mark A”.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
