The petitioner herein seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.4 and 5 to pay him retiral benefits such as gratuity, leave encashment etc. on retirement from service of respondent No.5-Society on attaining the age of superannuation.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his legal notice dated 02.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) ventilating his grievance, whereupon no decision has been taken as yet, is decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Mr. Athar Ahmed, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 4.

Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be furnished to the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of the day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to decide legal notice dated 02.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case the petitioner is found entitled to the retiral dues, as claimed, the same be released to him within a further period of six weeks along with interest @ 6% per annum.
