Prayer in both the petitions titled above is to grant regular bail to the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.351 dated 22.12.2022 registered under Sections 379-B/411/34 IPC (in CRM-M-15591 of 2023) and under Sections 379-B/34 IPC (Section 411 IPC added later on in CRM-M-23261 of 2023) at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Prosecution allegations are that on 22.12.2022, mobile phone of complainant Inder Kumar was snatched by the pillion rider, who was riding on a motor-cycle along with two others. Complainant could not

notice the registration number of the bike. Further prosecution case is that during investigation, both the present petitioners, i.e. Parminderjeet Singh and Arshdeep Singh along with co-accused Parminder Singh were arrested on 23.12.2022. Snatched phone was recovered from the possession of Parminder Singh.

It is contended by learned counsel for both the petitioners that no recovery has been effected from the petitioners; that they have been falsely implicated; that they have no criminal antecedents and that the trial may take time to conclude and therefore, they be allowed bail.

In the status report, filed by way of affidavit of Shri Varinder Singh Khosa, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar in CRM-M-15591 of 2023, it is conceded position that no recovery has been effected from any of the petitioners.

Custody certificate filed qua both the petitioners have been filed, which reveal that they are in custody for the last 06 months and 25 days with no criminal antecedents.

Having regarding to the afore-said facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner – Parminderjeet Singh (petitioner in CRM-M-15591 of 2023) and petitioner – Arshdeep Singh (petitioner in CRM-M-23261 of 2023) are admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

Both the petitions stand disposed of.
