The petitioner seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty and other family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7, with a further prayer to take appropriate legal action on representation dated 01.03.2023.

It is stated that private respondent Nos.4 to 7 used to harass and humiliate the wife of the petitioner. When the petitioner tried to make understand the private respondents, they illegally entered the house of the petitioner and inflicted injuries on him and other family members. He is stated to have been admitted in the Civil Hospital Ludhiana in this regard.

Precisely, in the context of aforesaid relief, petitioner has approached the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 01.03.2023 (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that petitioner would be satisfied if his representation dated 01.03.2023 is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab,

accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on perusal of the paper book, instant petition is *disposed of* with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the representation dated 01.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner and if necessary to take appropriate action on the same, as per law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of *two months*.
