ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 13.05.2019, vide which respondent-workman was held entitled to wages last drawn in terms of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act and the management was directed to release the payment.

The order dated 03.09.2019 passed in the earlier contempt petition bearing COCP No.3050 of 2019 reads as under: -

“After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.”

Since the petitioner has filed this second contempt petition instead of availing the alternative remedy, same is dismissed.
