Present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the
nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement the order
passed by this Court dated 19.08.2015 and ownership and mutation be
entered in the name of petitioners and their siblings as per the judgment
passed by this Court in RSA No.3621 of 1987 in regard to 70 Kanal 4
Marla of land as per Jamabandi for the year 2011-12.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that for entering the mutation, the petitioners approached the concerned authorities, however, no action was taken. He submits that for redressal of their grievances, they filed representation dated 16.12.2022 (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2-the Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Patiala but the same has not yet been decided. At this stage, Mr. Sudeep Mahajan, Advocate has appeared and opposed the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has also opposed the prayer made by the petitioners in this petition.

After hearing learned counsel for both the parties and perusing the material on record, it is apparent that representation dated 16.12.2022 (Annexure P-4) is pending consideration before respondent No.2, however the same has not been decided till date.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Collector, Patiala to look into the representation dated 16.12.2022 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioners and decide the same within a period of four weeks from today in accordance with law.
