This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ especially in the nature of certiorari for setting aside/quashing of the impugned order dated 22.03.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.1 vide which the appeal dated 02.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) filed against the impugned order dated 15.12.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2 has been dismissed and the application filed by the petitioner for transfer of the case has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the primary grievance of the petitioner is that the proceedings before the

Assistant Collector 1st Grade (Tehsildar)/respondent No.3 are being delayed. It is further submitted that although, the partition application was filed by respondent No.4 in the year 2020, only Naksha 'Arra' has been prepared. It is also submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to expedite the proceedings.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4 has submitted that it is their application and they have no objection in case respondent No.3 is directed to expedite the proceedings.

Keeping in view above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to expedite the proceedings.

It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.3 would consider the said case independently, in accordance with law.
