Through this second petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.257 dated 09.11.2019, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda, under Section 21 NDPS Act, 1985 and Sections 379, 411 and 473 IPC (added later on).

Status report dated 03.05.2023 by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-2 Bathinda, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
