The petitioner is seeking setting aside of order dated 21.12.2022 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sirsa in Complaint bearing No.NACT/1399 of 2021 dated 28.10.2021 titled as 'Virender Kumar Vs. Bhajan Singh' vide which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person and for quashing of FIR No.14 dated 06.01.2023 registered at Police Station Civil Line Sirsa under Section 174-A of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that non-bailable warrants issued against the petitioner were received back unexecuted and proceedings under Section 82 of the Cr.P.C. were initiated against the petitioner, who ultimately was declared a proclaimed person vide order dated 21.12.2022. He further submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he

would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Viney Phogat, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
