Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to investigate the FIR No.71 dated 04.02.2022, under Sections 297, 304-A, 337 of IPC, registered at Police Station Industrial Sector-29, Panipat and decide the representation dated 16.08.2022 (Annexure P-1).

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that after registration of the FIR, there is no progress in the investigation and thus, the same be handed over to some independent agency.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He, on instructions from ASI Raj Singh, has submitted that after investigation, the investigating agencies have prepared the untraced report and the same is to be filed before the competent Court of jurisdiction.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the State to file

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untraced report before the Court of competent jurisdiction within 15 days from today. Petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedy before the Court of competent jurisdiction as in accordance with law.
