This petition has been filed for issuing directions to respondent No.2 to take action against respondent No.4 and its members based upon representation dated 23.02.2023 (Annexure P2).

A perusal of the aforementioned representation shows that the petitioner is alleging that officials of Municipal Committee, Panipat are taking steps to illegally oust the petitioner from the land on which he had installed a laundry workshop with the intent of harassing him economically as well as mentally. Threats are also being issued.

Any action on the aforementioned representation would involve registration of an FIR. Thus, issuance of directions to act upon the representation would indirectly be a direction to register an FIR. For the said purpose, an equally efficacious and speedy remedy is available under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. and thus, I refrain from exercising jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
