Petitioner has approached this Court highlighting the non-providing of necessary drainage facilities etc. by the Municipal Council, Bahadurgarh-respondent No.4 as also the other authorities despite having been approached on various occasions and directions also having been issued. Legal notice dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) has also been served upon the respondents but till date no response thereto has been received nor any action in pursuance to the said legal notice taken for redressal of the grievance as highlighted in the said notice.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents No.2 to 5 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) within some reasonable time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Advocate,

accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the present writ petition at this stage by directing the Director General, Town and Country Planning, the District Town Planner, Jhajjar, the Secretary, Municipal Council, Bahadurgarh and the Estate Officer, HUDA, Bahadurgarh-respondents No.2 to 5 respectively to consider and decide the legal notice dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the grievance, as has been highlighted by the petitioner is accepted, immediate consequential steps be taken for redressal of the grievance.
