Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the action of the respondents, whereby the petitioner has not been allowed to join on the post of Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) Mathematics (HES-II), whereas the similarly situated person has been allowed to join on the post.

The short replies filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and 4 are already on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was working as a Constable in Delhi Armed Police and being fully eligible, he had applied for the post of PGT Mathematics (HES-II) through proper channel after taking permission from the Department. After selection, the petitioner was allotted the station but in the meantime, Election Code of Conduct came

in to force for the General Elections 2019 and when he approached respondent No.3 for joining the duty, he was not allowed to do so. Hence the present writ petition.

Learned State counsel submits that as per Para 4 of short reply dated 17.09.2020 filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3, the claim of the petitioner has already been considered by the respondents and he was allowed to join on the post of PGT Mathematics (HES-II) on 04.04.2019 and now the petitioner is working as such at Govt. Senior Secondary School, Nigana Kalan, Bhiwani. Thus, the present petition has become infructuous.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the case file.

Since the petitioner was allowed to join on the post of PGT Mathematics (HES-II) on 04.04.2019 and now the petitioner is working as such at Govt. Senior Secondary School, Nigana Kalan, Bhiwani, no further order is called for in the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
