The petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for a direction to respondent No.2 to grant parole to him for 2 weeks to arrange finances in order to give money to the complainant under mediation proceedings.

Reply dated 10.04.2023 filed by the respondent in Court, is taken on record.

In the light of the averments made in the reply to the effect that on the date of filing of the present petition, no application was either filed or was pending with the authorities to consider the case of the petitioner for grant of parole, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of this petition with liberty to file a fresh representation/application with the competent authority on the same cause of action. The authorities shall take a decision on the same representation/application, if any so made, within a period of two weeks, thereafter and the same shall be communicated to the petitioner in advance.
