Petitioners have approached this Court praying for quashing of GD/DDR/Kalendra No.23 dated 09.07.2022, under Section 107/150 Cr.P.C., registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the impugned Kalendra was invoked without any basis. He submits that the allegations levelled by respondent No.2 were false and frivolous and thus, the petitioners had filed the representation before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for directing the respondents-State to decide the representation (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the State to look into the representation (Anneuxre P-2) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of one month from today.
