1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to declare the result of 10th class of the petitioner and to upgrade him to 11th class.

2. Learned counsel for respondent no.2 has filed reply. The same is taken on record and paragraph 3 of the reply reads as under:-

“3. That the respondent No.3 could not upload the internal marks of the petitioner timely, therefore the result of the petitioner could not be declared but was declared by the answering respondent on 16.08.2022 and the same was also uploaded on the website, therefore the present writ petition has rendered infructuous. A copy of the mark sheet of the petitioner is annexed herewith as ANNEXURE A-1.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the stand taken by respondent no.2, has submitted that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
