Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing/modifying the result dated 10.04.2022 (Annexure P-7) to the extent that the petitioner has not been selected for the post of Staff Nurse in the Department of Health as advertised, vide advertisement No.15/2019 dated 07.09.2019 (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was a candidate for the post of Staff Nurse in the EWS category. He submits that despite having been submitted all the documents, candidature of the petitioner has not been considered in the said category. It is his specific case

that the petitioner has scored 48 marks in the written examination and additional 05 marks were granted under the socio economic criteria, taking her tally to 53 marks and the last candidate selected in this category has got 50 marks. A submission has been made that 25 posts are lying vacant. Counsel submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-8) bringing all these facts to the notice of respondent No.2, but no action has been taken. He submits that petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into representation (Annexure P-8).

Despite repeated opportunities, no reply has been filed by the respondents. However, given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it appropriate to wait for the response.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the claim of the petitioner on merits, petition is disposed of with a direction to Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission-respondent No.2 to examine the grievance of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and pass a speaking order thereon.
