The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.154 dated 29.03.2022 registered under Sections 379-B, 395, 506, 411, 392 IPC and Section 28-54-59 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has been falsely implicated; that no Test Identification Parade was ever conducted; that recovery of ₹1,500/- has been shown from the

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petitioner. It is also contended by learned counsel that similarly placed
co-accused, namely, Sandeep has already been allowed bail vide order
dated 02.03.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-3577 of 2023.

Custody certificate alongwith reply has been placed on
record by learned State counsel. As per the custody certificate placed on
record, petitioner is in custody for last 6 months and 12 days.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances and
on the ground of parity also, but without commenting anything on the
merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail
bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief Judicial
Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
