This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents not to raise any kind of construction/path/passage/sewage plant/pipes in the land in question.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4 as well as learned State counsel have submitted that they have not raised any construction in the land in question.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 has submitted that a

road had already been constructed in the year 2003 in the land in question and further no construction is being raised by them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to avail appropriate remedy in case any cause survives.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
