1. By way of filing instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner, who is the complainant has approached this Court seeking a direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct a fair and proper investigation in FIR No.120 dated 09.06.2021, under Sections 454, 380 IPC, registered at Police Station A Division Amritsar, Annexure P1.

2. In response to notice issued by this Court, State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, East, Amritsar on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, wherein it has been submitted that during investigation no incriminating evidence could be found against Kalas Palvanda, Suksham Palvanda, Jagdish Kumar and Ramesh Kumar. It has been further submitted that an untraced

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report has been prepared and shall be presented before the Area Magistrate very soon. Upon instructions from SI Waris Masih, State counsel submits that the report has been approved by the senior official.

3. In view of the above development, petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondents to present the final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. before the competent Magistrate within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order.
