1. The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoner (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 for release of petitioner on regular parole for 10 weeks.
2. As per the reply, the 10 weeks' of regular parole has been sanctioned as per Annexure R-1 by the Commissioner, Faridabad Division on 13.04.2023. The same has also been forwarded to the District Magistrate, Supaul, Bihar and the concerned police officials vide the letter dated 07.01.2023, which is apparently in reference to the earlier communications addressed on 23.02.2023, 17.03.2023 and 05.04.2023.
3. In such circumstances, as per the warrant itself, the personal bond has to be furnished before the District Magistrate, Supaul, Bihar alongwith two sureties and, therefore, it is for the petitioner as such to do the needful. The petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous leaving the petitioner to do the needful before the concerned authorities.
