Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.PC seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.40 dated 10.03.2023, under Sections 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC later on added), registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel has filed the status report dated 11.04.2023, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.
