DEEPAK GUPTA, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.297 dated 01.09.2022 registered under Sections 379-B, 392, 34 of the IPC (Section 324, 392, 394, 397 of IPC was added later on) registered at Police Station City Assauda, District Jhajjar.

As per the FIR version three-four person caught-hold of the complainant namely Dayal Ram on 31.08.2022 at about 07:30 p.m., gave a cut on his right ear and snatched a mobile phone which was of Vivo model.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he is not named in the FIR; that no *ruqa* was ever sent to the police regarding the injury sustained by the complainant; that no Test Identification Parade was conducted; that after his arrest on 01.02.2022, investigation has since been completed; that co-accused Amarpal had already been allowed bail.

Custody certificate has been placed on record by learned State counsel revealing that petitioner is in custody for the last 7 months and 10 days with no criminal antecedents.

Admittedly, petitioner is not named in the FIR. Two co-accused have already been allowed bail. Recovery of snatched mobile was not effected from the petitioner. Trial may take time to conclude.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
