Main case

The petitioner has filed the present petition seeking anticipatory bail
in a case FIR No.626 dated 18.11.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC,
registered at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

By virtue of the order dated 05.06.2020, while granting interim
protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the
petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the

interim order may kindly be made absolute. He further submits that the main accused has already been granted regular bail.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 05.06.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
