Prayer in this application is for exemption from placing on record the certified copy of the order dated 18.03.2023 (Annexure P-6) and further for placing on record the true typed copy of the said order.

The application is allowed as prayed for subject to just exceptions. The order dated 18.03.2023 (Annexure P-6) is taken on record.

Prayer in the present petition is for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who was declared a proclaimed person vide order dated 03.01.2022 (Annexure P-4), passed in a complaint case No.NACT-667-2018, titled as M/s Brar Filling Station vs. M/s United Roads Infra Tech Pvt. Ltd.

and others, under Section 138 read with Section 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction be given to the trial Court that in case the petitioner surrenders and files an application for bail, the same be decided on the same day.

This Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter or accede to the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner as the complaint in question was filed in 2018 and the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person on 03.01.2022. The petitioner, if so advised, may surrender before the trial Court to avail his remedies as it is well settled that no interim relief deserves to be granted to a person who has been declared a proclaimed person and has absented himself from Court proceedings.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.

However, nothing observed herein shall be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
