AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the plot, which has been purchased by the petitioner in an auction from the bank is virtually now surrounded all around by various buildings, which have come forth leaving almost no access to the said plot. Petitioner has been approaching the respondents for the redressal of the grievance but without any result thereto. Counsel has referred to the representation dated 06.12.2021 (Annexure P-5). On this, certain correspondence has taken place between the departments i.e. HSVP as well as HSIIDC but without any result. It is an acknowledged position that as of now there is no access to the plot in question.

Counsel thus contends that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to the Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula-respondent No.2 and Administrator, HSVP, Faridabad-respondent No.3 within a period of two weeks from today, which may be considered and decided within some

specified time.

Prayer of the petitioner's counsel is accepted.

If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and a decision taken thereon within a period of eight weeks after giving hearing to the petitioner. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

The writ petition stands disposed of with above directions.
