1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-1).
2. A perusal of representation (Annexure P-1) reveals that the prayer therein was for direction to the Deputy Superintendent of Police not to harass the petitioners by calling them repeatedly to the Police Station
3. Status Report dated 31.05.2023 by way of affidavit of Jarnail Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, Punjab has been filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 & 2. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite. Para 2 of the said status report has been reproduced as under:-

“That at the very outset it is respectfully submitted that the petitioners are not being called by any of the police officer of District Rupnagar, nor they are being harassed as alleged by them in the instant petition. It is further submitted that the petitioner failed to mention any date or month in the present petition, as to when they were unnecessary called, summoned

or harassed by any police officer of the District Rupnagar. It is further submitted that since the petitioners were never summoned, called or harassed, as claimed by the petitioners in the instant petition, by the any of the police officer of the District Rupnagar, therefore, the petitioners have no cause of action to file the present petition and the same is abuse of process of land and is liable to be dismissed. ”

4. A perusal of order sheet shows that there has been no representation on behalf of the petitioners on the last date of hearing i.e. 31.05.2023. Even today, no one appears on behalf of the petitioners.

5. In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel no further directions are warranted in the matter. Present petition accordingly stands disposed of in view of status report by way of affidavit filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2-State.
