Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 34 dated 05.02.2023, registered under Sections 307, 34, 341, 452, 506 IPC and Sections 25(1-B) (a) and Section 27 (added later on) of the Arms Act, at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram.

Vide order dated 29.03.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 29.03.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Satish, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.03.2023 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
