VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the present petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1199 dated 27.12.2022, registered under Sections 451, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar.

2. On 11.04.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and has been falsely implicated. He submits that it was some domestic and personal dispute between the parties which has been given the colour of a criminal case. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the main accused Sonia Sahni has already joined investigation. He further submits that even the petitioner is willing to join investigation and abide by the conditions imposed by this Court.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, Asstt.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

List on 17.05.2023.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Arresting/Investigating Officer and join investigation. In the event of arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to compliance of the provisions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the said order dated 11.04.2023, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned counsel representing the respondent-State of Haryana, on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.04.2023, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 11.04.2023, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
