Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to appear for scrutiny of documents for Group 'D' post in ESP category against Advt. No. 04/2018 Cat. No.1 and to consider the candidature of the petitioner in the selection process.

On 09.03.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

“Result of the petitioner has been produced in a sealed cover in compliance of order dated 06.09.2022. Sealed cover is ordered to be opened and result is taken on record.

Perusal of the result shows that the petitioner, who was an applicant for Group-D post in ESP(SC) category, has scored 34 marks, whereas, last selected candidate in his category has 40 marks and the last candidate on the waiting list has 36 marks.

State counsel submits that in view of the result of the petitioner, no fruitful purpose would be served in keeping the petition pending.

As the matter has been taken up after the Court time is over, list on 10.03.2023.

To be shown in the urgent cause list.”

In view of above, writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
