Learned senior counsel for the petitioner alleges that in terms of the order dated 04.10.2008 passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench, neither any policy decision is taken by the State Government for removal/regularization of the encroachment nor the Improvement Trust has taken up the effective measures for removing the encroachment of the remaining portion of the land, which is still under unauthorized possession.

Since no official of State of Punjab is impleaded as a party, learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to file afresh petition with better particulars.
