The present petition has been filed under 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct a fair and proper investigation in case FIR No.358 dated 13.11.2020 registered under sections 379, 408, 443, 451, 452, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station, Naraingarh, Ambala.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigation is complete and a cancellation report has already been filed by the investigating agency before the court of learned JMIC, Naraingarh. He submits that since this case is pending since long, the Magistrate concerned may be directed to decide the matter expeditiously after hearing both the sides. He also submits that petitioner would file his protest petition before the court concerned.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this court finds that as the cancellation report has already been filed, no further order is required to be passed in this petition. However, keeping in view the pendency of the case before the learned Magistrate concerned, present

petition is disposed of with a direction to the Magistrate concerned to decide the case pending after filing of the cancellation report, on hearing both the sides expeditiously, as in accordance with law, preferably within a month.
