On 29.03.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.489 dated 30.08.2016 registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 302, 379-B/353, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act 54 of 1959 at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was found to be innocent during the course of investigation and has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Therefore, no case for custodial interrogation is made out.

Mr. Kanwar Sanjiv Kumar, Asstt. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and on his do so, he has shall be admitted to the interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The Counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance of the interim order, the petitioner has surrendered and has since been released on bail vide order dated 31.03.2023.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in this case.

Disposed of.

However, it is expected that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent himself in future but for sufficient cause.
