This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of notice dated 02.03.1996 issued by respondent No.2 vide which the petitioners have been asked to deposit a balance due of Rs.15,500/- as fee for the session of 1995-96 by treating them to have been admitted against payments seats and further refusing to entertain the examination form of the petitioners.
