The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.84 dated 16.03.2018 registered under Section 420 of the IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana on the basis of the compromise (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Keeping in view the report received from the Civil Judge, Junior Division-cum- Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Ludhiana dated 09.09.2019, the petitioner is a proclaimed offender.

That being so, prayer as raised in the present petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise and that too on the asking of the proclaimed offender is not permissible.

Keeping in view the above, no ground to allow the prayer of the petitioner is made out and the present petition is accordingly dismissed.
