The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of part of the order dated 21.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad whereby petitioner has been admitted to bail on furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one local surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Court with further condition that he shall either furnish bank draft in favour of the complainant for an amount of Rs.8,40,000/- (50% of the cheque amount) or bank guarantee to the extent of Rs.8,40,000/- or FDR to the extent of Rs.8,40,000/- and with a further condition that if the draft is furnished by him, it shall be retained in the Court file. The said condition has been impugned in the present petition.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent submits that due to the interim order passed by this Court dated 09.07.2018, the main appeal has been adjourned repeatedly by the learned Lower Appellate Court inspite of the fact that there is no stay with regard to the proceedings before the Court below. He submits that at this stage, he does not press for the said condition of depositing 50% of the cheque amount and the impugned order may be set aside.

In view of the statement made on behalf of the respondent, the part of the impugned order dated 21.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) in question is hereby set aside.

Present petition stands disposed off, accordingly.
