The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 33 dated 24.03.2019 under Sections 420 and 409 IPC registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has supplied a copy of the order passed by the trial Court vide which it is stated that the petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs. 05 lac in the shape of FDR No. 41184161687 dated 08.08.2022 of SBI Branch Sardulgarh. He contends that in

compliance of order dated 27.07.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pargat Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 27.07.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
