Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Lakhwinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East, Amritsar, (additional charge) has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 3 & 4 to 6 in compliance of the order dated 13.04.2023. The relevant part of the report reads as under:

“That it is submitted that therefore, in pursuance to the enquiry report submitted by the Enquiry Officer through SHO P.S. A-Division, Amritsar a detailed report was submitted to the Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, City-3, Amritsar, who further submitted his detailed forwarding report to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar wherein recommendation was made to file and consign the above said representation (Annexure P/4) bearing No. 118729-PGD dated 21.02.2023 to record room. Hence, the same has been filed and consigned to record room in the office of the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. The report bearing No. 772-5AP dated 27.04.2023 of the Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, City-3, Amritsar is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1/T for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.”

In view of the aforesaid report, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Court of concerned Area Magistrate, in case, he is not satisfied with the report. If any such complaint is filed, the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law.
