The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.133 dated 23.03.2021 under Sections 177, 199, 200, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.01.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 16.01.2023
