The petitioner-union is espousing the interest of its members. Grievance raised in the writ petition relates to disbursal of arrears of salary in accordance with the orders dated 19.04.2017 (Annexure P-7) and that dated 05.12.2016 (Annexure P-6/A).

2. Present petition has been filed seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to hear and decide legal notice dated 14.01.2019 (Annexure P-10) served at the behest of the petitioner.

3. Mr. Prashar appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 submits that he has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by the petitioner.

4. Resultantly, the present writ petition is disposed off with the direction to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice dated 14.01.2019 placed at Annexure P-10 in accordance with law within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case the petitioner is entitled, the necessary relief be disbursed within a further period of 02 weeks thereafter. In case respondent No.1 opines that the claim as raised by the petitioner-union does not deserve acceptance, the same shall be adjudicated by passing a speaking order and after affording an

opportunity of personal hearing within the time period as stipulated hereinabove.

5. Ordered accordingly.
