HARKESH MANUJA, J.

By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0037 dated 11.05.2020 registered under Section 307, 323, 506, 427, 454, 380, 148 149 IPC and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

Having been granted concession of regular bail vide order dated 30.06.2020 by the trial Court in the aforementioned FIR, the petitioner absented himself resulting into cancellation of his bail bonds/forfeiture of surety bonds. On 31.03.2023, this Court passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that having been granted concession of regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 30.06.2020, the petitioner absented himself on 29.09.2022 on account of some personal difficulty as he was travelling out of State. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner is ready to furnish his requisite bonds.

Notice of motion for 19.04.2023.

Mr. Vinay Kumar Gupta, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In the meanwhile, no coercive steps shall be taken

against the petitioner and the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court within a week and furnish his bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

In pursuance thereof, petitioner furnish his fresh bail bond/surety bonds which was accepted by the trial Court. The order dated 05.04.2023 passed by the trial Court is reproduced hereunder:

“Present: Applicant/accused Gurwinder Singh in person with counsel Sh.APS Dhanju, Advocate.

File is taken up today on the application filed by the learned counsel for accused Gurwinder Singh for acceptance of bail bonds in pursuance of order dated 31.03.2023 passed by Hon’ble High Court in CRM-M-16336 of 2023 in case titled as ‘Gurwinder Singh Vs. State’. Vide the above said order accused Gurwinder Singh was ordered to be released on anticipatory bail and was directed to appear before the trial Court within a week and furnish his bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction. I have purused the said order, which has been confirmed from the CIS System by the Ahlmad. In view of the order of Hon’ble High Court, accused Gurwinder Singh is directed to furnish bail bonds/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with on surety in the like amount. Bonds are furnished, which are accepted and attested.

Certified copy of Jamabandi for the year 2020-21 of land bearing khewat No.123/114 situated at village Hamad Wala Hithar, Tehsil Mallanwala, District Ferozepur is also attached with the bonds. Copy of this order along with copy of Jamabandi sent to Collector, Ferozepur to make an entry in the revenue record under intimation to this Court. File be put up on the date fixed.
