Learned State counsel has placed on record a copy of speaking order dated 02.08.2023, vide which, in paragraph Nos. 4 and 5, the following observations are made:

“4. After scrutiny of the record, it has been transpired that the petitioner has not received/claimed any amount of Leave Encashment or Gratuity from Punjab State Leather Development Corporation Ltd.

5. Therefore, as per Finance Department (FPPC), Government of Punjab instructions dated 13.10.2016, the previous service of the petitioner rendered in Punjab State Leather Development Corporation Ltd. shall be counted for the purpose of pension/pensionary benefits subject to the petitioner deposits the employer's share of CPF with 12% S.I.”

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has to pay the employer's share of CPF with 12% simple interest and only thereafter, further benefits will be released.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent that as and when the petitioner performs his part of depositing the amount of CPF, as stated above, the needful be done within a period of two months thereafter.

Rule stands discharged.
