HARKESH MANUJA, J.

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.0051 dated 31.03.2019, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

2. On 31.03.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

Learned counsel for petitioner inter alia submits that in the FIR in question, the petitioner was granted concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 31.05.2019 and has been continuously appearing before trial Court, but for 09.05.2022, when the petitioner was not keeping well. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before the trial Court and shall continue to appear and face trial.

Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, A.A.G., Haryana who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In the meanwhile, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner pertaining to aforementioned FIR, however, he shall surrender before trial Court on or before next date of hearing fixed before it i.e. 15.04.2023 and shall furnish his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.

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3. In pursuance to aforesaid order, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial court on 15.04.2023 and has furnished his fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
4. In view thereof, the petition is allowed and order dated 31.03.2023 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial court on each and every date unless granted exemption specifically.
