1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to set aside the order dated 13.12.2019 and 18.01.2021 passed by respondents no.2 and 3.

2. On 21.03.2022 it was noticed by a coordinate Bench of this Court that notice could not be issued to respondent no.4 as process fee was not filed and accordingly fresh notice was ordered to be issued for 12.10.2022 on filing of process fee. Even on 12.10.2022 the office report indicated that process fee had not been filed and thus, notice could not be issued to respondent no.4 and none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Even today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Interim order dated 29.04.2021 also shows that the interim order had been passed in favour of the petitioner till the next date of hearing subject to the petitioner clearing all arrears of licence fee within a period of four weeks. The said interim order has not been continued.

3. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
