The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the arrears of LTC for the period 01.01.2016 to 31.12.2020 and old age allowance for the period 01.01.2016 to 31.05.2022 along with interest @ 9% on delayed payments.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the payment towards arrears of LTC has been made to the petitioner and petitioner does not want to press the present writ petition.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
