Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to get the investigation of the case bearing FIR No.44 dated 27.02.2023 under Section 302, 323, 336, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Distrcit Amritsar.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to the limited issue that the Investigating Agency be directed to preserve the CCTV footage in which the entire incident had been captured.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the State has no objection in preserving the CCTV footage of the incident.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, the present petition is disposed of in the said terms.
